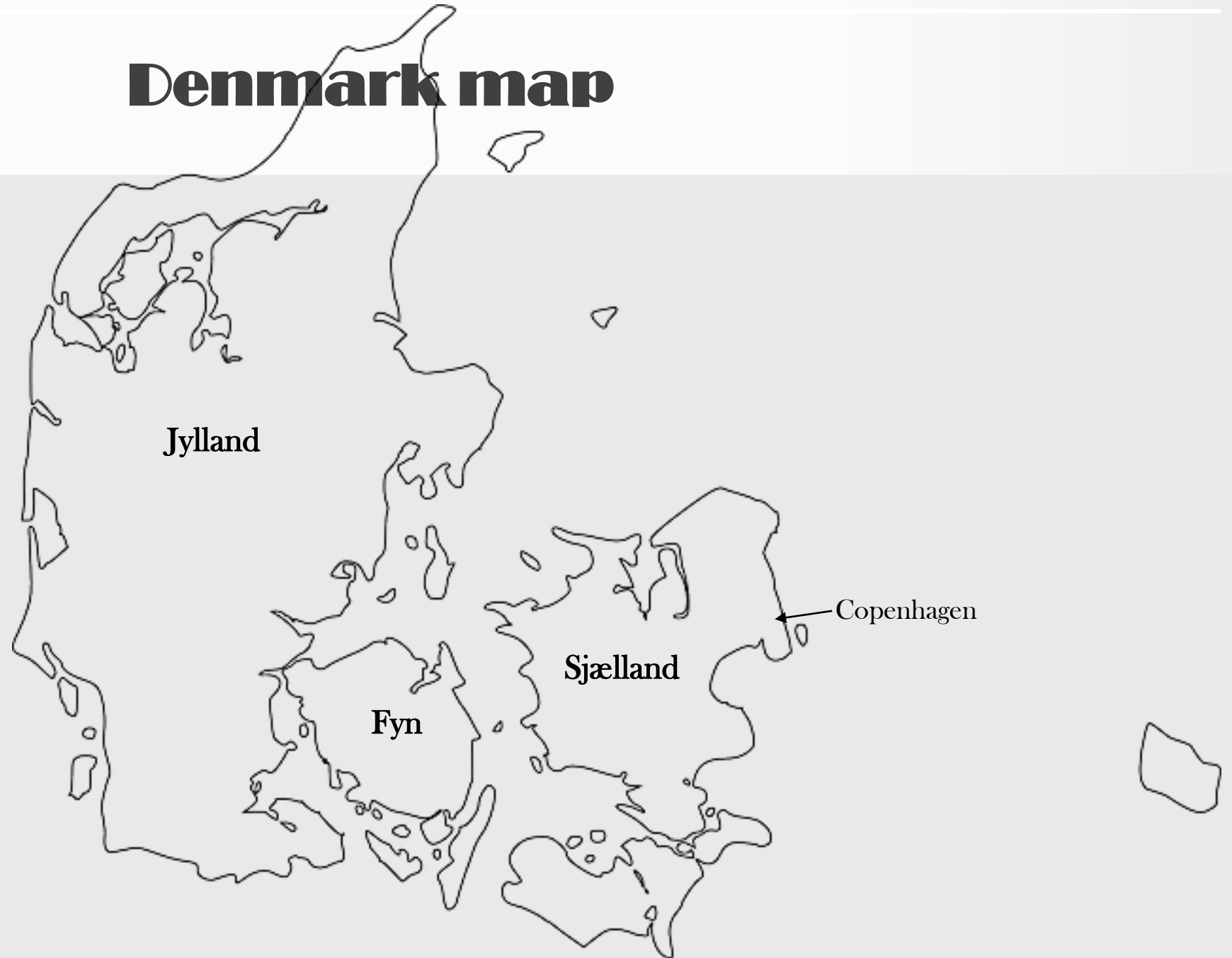

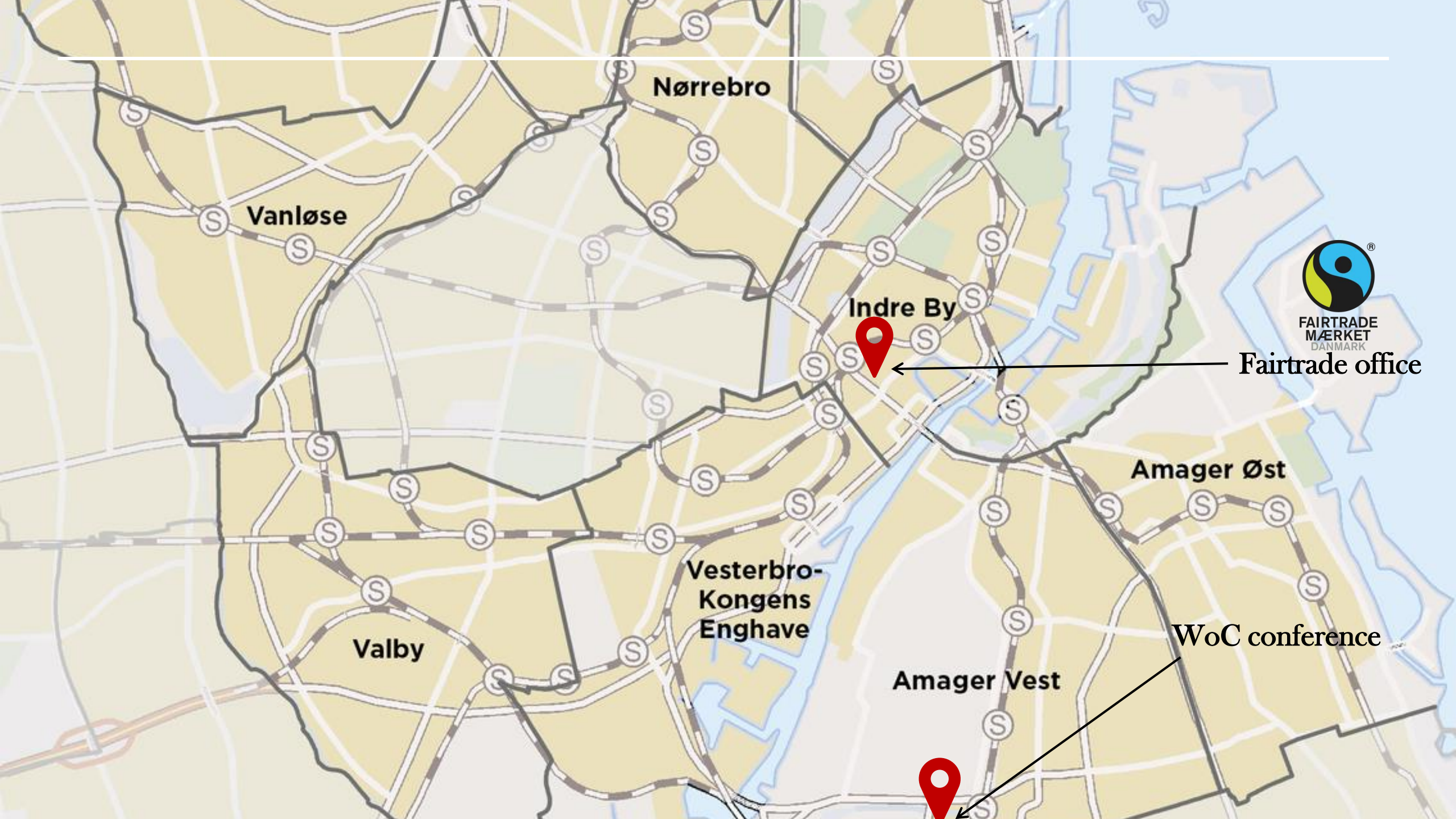

# Rundetårn

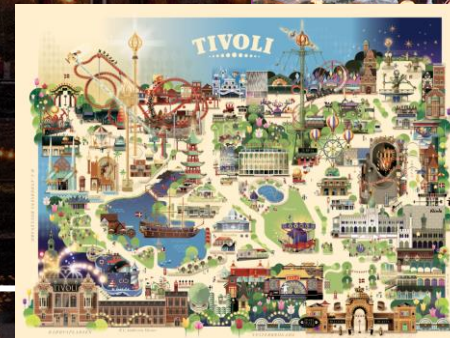
Rundetårn (Round Tower) is a living landmark of Copenhagen since 1642. Located in the city centre and can be accessed from the shopping street, Strøget.

# Public Transport

You can buy a travel card at the main station and refill at most stations. You can also add people on your travelcard for an extra charge.



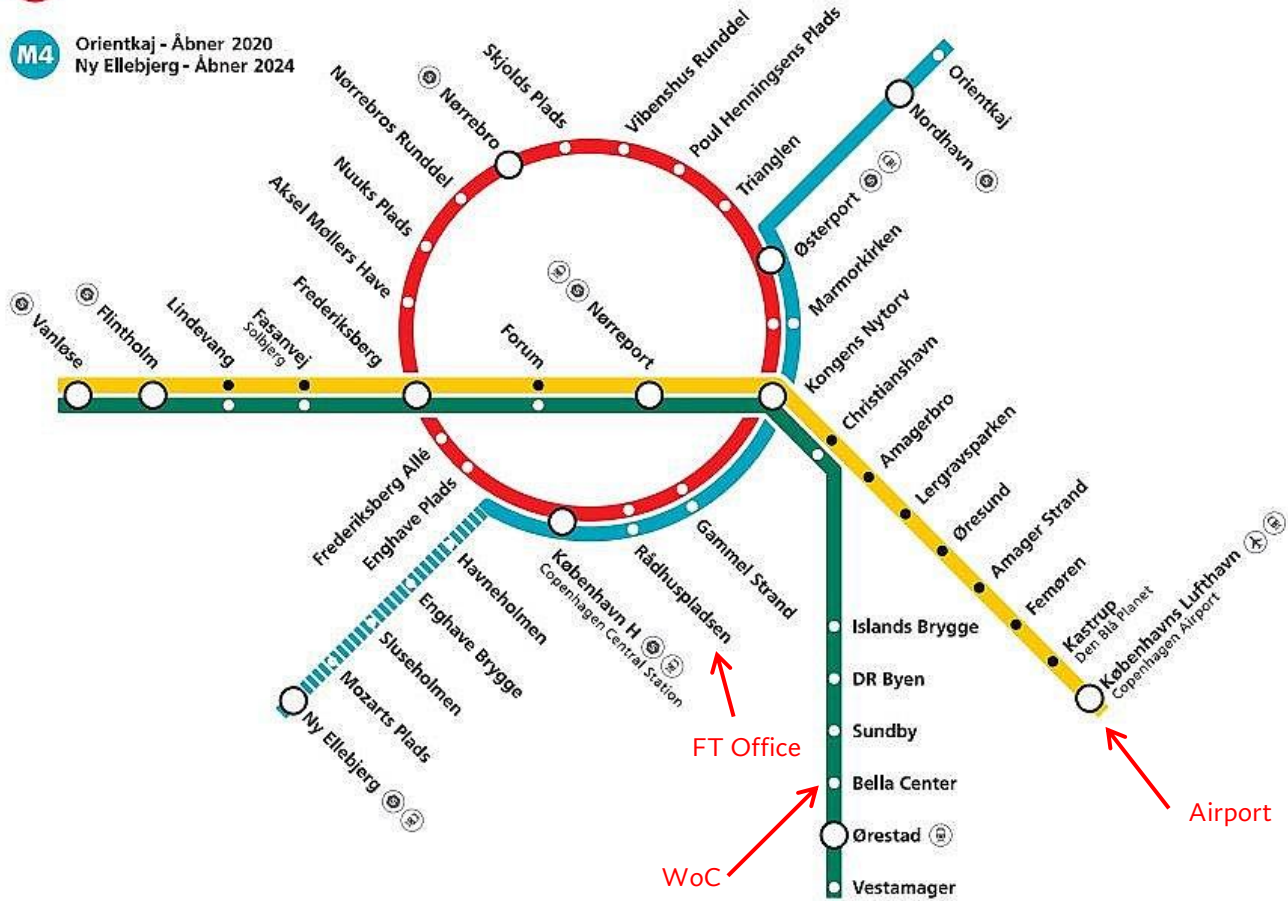
In Denmark we use 'rejsekort'='travel card', which we check-in and check-out of every time we go on any public transport.

We fill it up by machines that can be found at almost every station

You can also purchase day tickets (or multiple days) at the stations

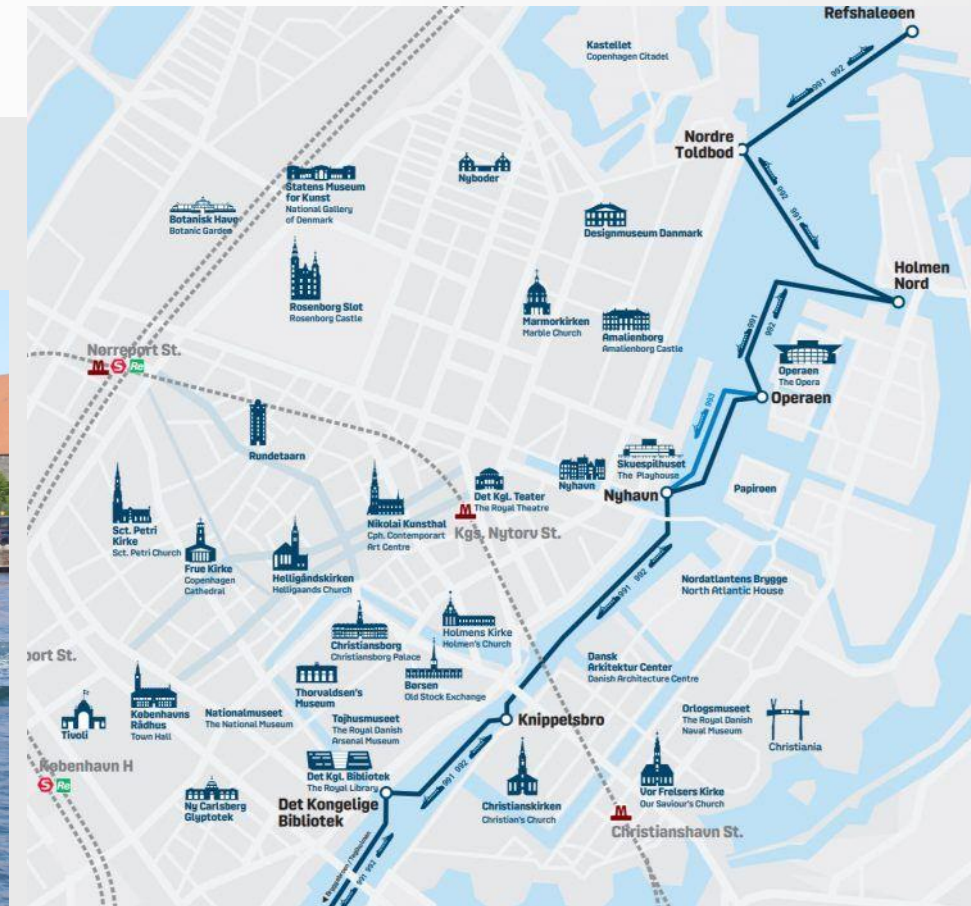

Hygge is a BIG part of the Danish culture



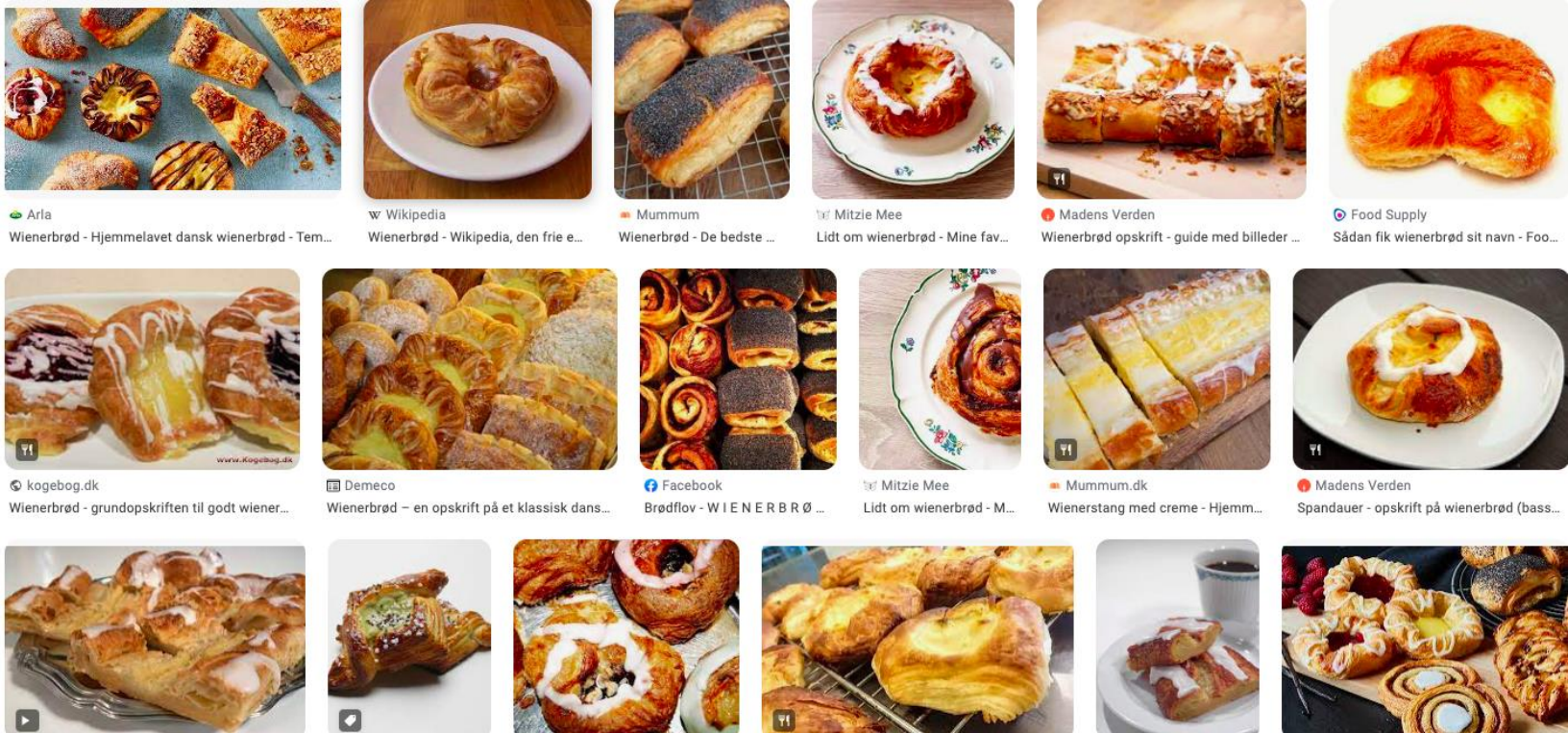
# Danish pastry (Wienerbrød)

# Smørrebrød (traditional lunch)

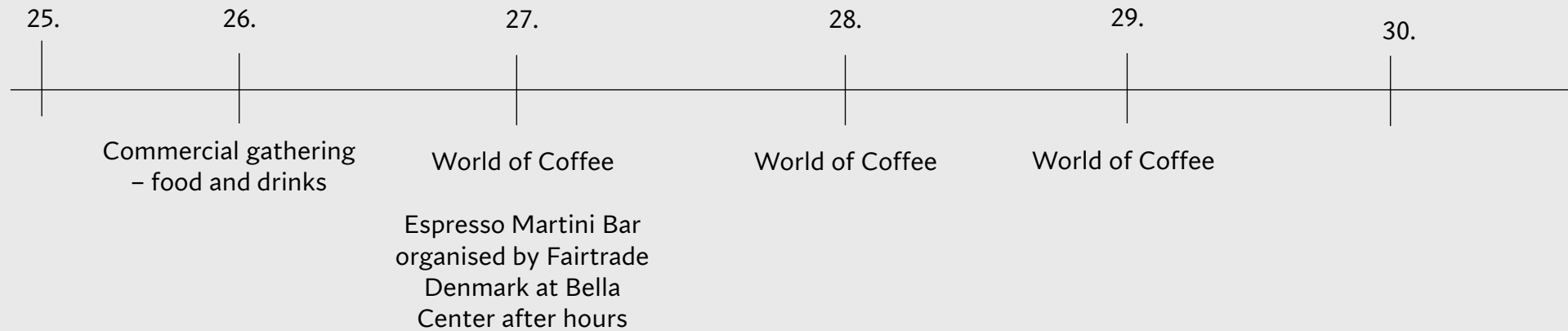
Smørrebrød: a traditional open-faced sandwich made on rye bread.
